一、产品设计背景

在"新课标、新教材、新高考"的体系下,英语教学急需按照"主题语境"要求组织的素材。

- 新课标(2017版): 明确提及的核心是主题语境,分为三大主题,32个子主题,主题下结合语篇载体进行纵深的挖掘,语言知识及其他则附着在主题语境和语篇类型中。

So what's senior high school really like? Is there more work? More stress? If you're having thoughts like these, you're not alone: lots of other **freshmen** are feeling the same way. With that in mind, here are some topics that commonly worry freshmen and some things you might want to learn about.

Learning inside the classroom

The work in high school **builds on** what you learned in middle school, giving you a more advanced knowledge of many **academic** subjects. So you may find you have more work to do or that it's more challenging. But these challenges can make you feel less bored with the usual routine. It's perfectly OK if you're nervous as a freshman at first. Just be patient and keep trying. Once you get used to your new independence, you may find you can go further than you ever imagined.



My own experience in senior high school has been filled with more memories, laughter, stress, and—most importantly, growth—than I ever could have expected when I began. The lessons I have learned in those years have shaped who I am today, and that person is far from the 14-year-old girl who walked through those glass doors of La Salle nearly four years ago.

As a freshman, I tried to **adjust to** what felt like a new world and tried to make friends as I had only one. I never knew what it was like to feel alone in a school with so many people. I felt like I had to act a certain way or be a certain person in order to **maintain** a **basic** conversation with people in my classes or on my soccer team.

We put limits on ourselves when the fear of failure grows stronger than our will to succeed. That's why we all need a push to help us **overcome** fear and reach further than we ever thought possible.

That is the purpose of NubAbility Athletics Foundation, a **non-profit** organization aiming to get "limb(肢体) different" teens "out of the stands, off the bench, and into sports". 

Two years ago, two high-school classmates each worked out a trigonometric proof of the Pythagorean theorem (毕达哥拉斯定理的三角证明). Now, at age 19, they've reported finding 10 more proofs of it.

For 2,000 years, such proofs were considered impossible. But that didn't <u>deter</u> Ne'Kiya Jackson and Calcea Johnson. The pair published their new ones on October 28 in *American Mathematical Monthly*.

"Some people have the impression that you have to be in the mathematical field for years and years before you can actually produce some new mathematics," says Álvaro Lozano-Robledo, a mathematician who works at the University of Connecticut in Storrs. "But Jackson and Johnson show that you can make achievements even as a high-school student."

The teens studied Pythagoras' theorem whose formula(公式) has been proven many times using **algebra** and **geometry** but people thought it could never be proven using the rules of trigonometry (三角学).

However, mathematician Jason Zimba **announced** the first trig-based proof of Pythagoras' theorem in 2009. The second came six years later, from mathematician Nuno Luzia. These were the only two until 2022, when Jackson and Johnson **presented** their first proofs. At the time, both were seniors at St Mary's Academy. It's a private school for young Black women in New Orleans.

Jackson and Johnson only published five proofs and decided to leave another five proofs "for interested readers to discover", they wrote in the paper. Jackson hopes the proofs will encourage other students to "see that difficulties are part of the **process**. With this in your mind, you might find yourself achieving more than you thought possible".

Publishing the proofs was a big achievement. But that doesn't mean the story is over. "Now, other people might take the paper and **generalize** those proofs, or generalize their ideas," mathematician Lozano-Robledo says. "It just opens up lots of mathematical conversations."





要写出完整、正确的句子,前提是掌握句子的成分和结构。

句子有若干个组成部分,分别承担着不同的作用,这些组成部分叫作句子成分。英语中的句子成分分为:主语(Subject)、谓语(Predicate)、宾语(Object)、表语(Predicative)、定语(Attribute)、状语(Adverbial)、补语(Complement)和同位语(Appositive)。

▶ 主语——发号施令于句首

主语是谓语所表示动作或状态的执行者。主语 一般位于句子开头,且不能省略。

但在某些特定的句式里,如疑问句、倒装句、祈 使句、感叹句等,句子主语也可以位于谓语动词之后 或省略。
