Nature is more than beautiful for one to look at.

For Indonesian nature conservationist (环保主义者) Farwiza Farhan, nature is a silent friend. As a child, Farhan often climbed trees whenever she had problems, staying there until she calmed down. Nature has always been there for her. This is why she has been trying to be there for nature when it needs her help.

Farhan brought her love for nature to her college years. She took a master's degree in environmental management at the University of Queensland in Australia. In 2009, while studying at the university, she had an opportunity to work with Global Carbon Capture and Storage Institute, an international think tank that focused on carbon capture and storage to cut down emissions (排放), and earned some money. In 2012, along with several of her co-workers, she formed the Forest, Nature and Environment of Aceh Foundation (HAkA).

In 2014, HAkA achieved one huge victory: making an oil company pay \$ 30 million for the damage it caused to the ecosystem. Farhan said this landmark victory was historic because it was the first time that Indonesia had fined a company for burning forests. Besides, HAkA also stopped the construction of a dam that put an elephant habitat in Indonesia at risk. HAkA, now a 12-year-old institution, also has programmes for women such as assistant lawyer and citizen journalism training and forest guard groups.

Farhan said they saw a need to empower women as protectors of the environment because women are much more affected by the effects of environmental destruction and climate change. The conservationist said disasters such as crop failures could affect the financial status (财政状况) of families, making it more likely for them to force women to be in arranged marriages to get out of poverty or relocate to areas full of

Farhan has won several awards and she commented, "The work should include everyone from all walks of life. The recognition belongs to all fighting on the ground."

Let's get one thing straight: Studying sometimes is boring, right? But it is extremely necessary. After all, working through difficult

materials is a necessary part of the learning process—which leads to the obvious question: If I have to do it, is there at least a way to make it fun?

During Carol S. Dweck's research for her book Mindset (思维模式): The New Psychology of Success, she found that students deal with learning in one of the two ways: they either look at difficult courses with a fixed mindset or with a growth mindset. Those with fixed mindsets believe that intelligence and talent are set in stone. For example, if they find a certain maths problem difficult, they'd think, "I guess I'm just not a maths person." In contrast, students with growth mindsets are certain that they could change and grow in every area of their lives. If they come across a difficult problem, they will think, "I can get better at this... But I have to tough it out."

Dweck found that most students start out pretty interested in a subject. Yet over the semester, something happens. Students with the fixed mindset may stay interested only when they do well right away. Those who find it difficult are likely to show a big drop in their interest and enjoyment. If it isn't a testimony (证明) to their intelligence, they can't enjoy it. In contrast, students with the growth mindset are able to continue to show the same high level of enjoyment even when they find the work very difficult. Difficulty and interest go hand in hand.

If you want to succeed and enjoy your study, don't think of your classes as a series of tests that show just how intelligent or unintelligent you are. Instead, think of them more as ongoing opportunities to learn and grow.

Keegan Cook's experience reads like a story—

a story of a California kid whose adventures in volleyball shaped his life from college to career (职业生涯).

Like many good stories, the UW (University of Washington) Volleyball Head Coach's story begins with a hero: his big sister, Meg. As a kid, he was taken to all her volleyball tournaments (联赛). Then he'd take a ball and play by himself in a corner of the gym. He wanted to do what she'd done.

After playing volleyball in high school, he followed Meg to St Mary's College of California, where he volunteered to coach almost the moment he arrived.

"For four years while the rest of my classmates were going to music festivals or travelling abroad, I was spending all my free time coaching," Keegan explains. "When you're 18 years old and coaching 17-year-olds, you have to be professional and mature. You have to take your job very seriously. I was very careful about those things early on."

Keegan graduated from St Mary's on a Friday in 2007 and, three days later, started his first professional job as a full-time assistant coach at this school.

While he loved St Mary's, Keegan was <u>intrigued by</u> the values of all the UW coaches and players he met while playing Washington. When an assistant coaching opportunity opened at the UW in 2013, he won the role.

With a degree in mathematics, Keegan puts his analytical (分析的) skills to use as a head coach who makes objective (客观的) decisions about practice schedules. "I believe in the influence of little behaviours repeated day after day so they become a powerful force in your life." It's a way of thinking that has led to four Pac-12 championships, eight trips to the NCAA Tournament, and many excellent players and proud UW graduates since Keegan joined UW Volleyball.

Dr Degenaar came into the lecture room on the first Friday morning of the term and asked us to write down our own understanding of the "soul". Here was the "teacher" asking us what we thought—it was really an exciting experience. He was not telling us what he thought but asking us how we saw something. The following discussion was interesting. That was my first experience of real learning in a classroom.

Almost 50 years have passed since that experience. Of the other lecturers who "taught" me during that year, I remember they "taught" me the history of Greek philosophy (哲学), but I remember little of that history and nothing of those lecturers. And most of what I remember about Greek philosophy is what I learned in Dr Degenaar's class, for my own interest.

I took further courses with Dr Degenaar in the following years. Like the first class, there was little "lecturing" at us, but far more involvement (参与) of us all in a process of common discovery in which we learned a lot about each other and the key points of the day. The excitement of discovery stays with me. Then it took me almost another 20 years to get a deeper understanding of what had happened in that lecture hall: experiential learning.

Traditionally, learners have been seen as "empty containers" waiting to be "filled" with learning given to them by the teacher. The learner is, therefore, dependent on the teacher for what to think and how to think. Compliance (遵从) is rewarded and so independent and original thinking is not developed.

In comparison, in experiential learning, the learner is encouraged to think for himself/herself, not to repeat the thought patterns of the teacher. The learning happens not because of what a "teacher" or a "lecturer" says but because of what the learner does. In this sense, I think this is the best way to learn and everyone should try it and learn from it.
