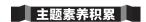

During times like these, some frustrated gardeners may wish their plants would just tell them what they need. A new Microsoft-partnered project in the UK is trying to see if that concept can be realized in the real world.

Next year, the Royal Horticultural Society in England will show off an "intelligent garden" that uses an AI model to monitor the garden's environment and inform gardeners when it needs care. Visitors can ask the AI-powered garden questions. The model could then respond with phrases like "I need a bit more water" or "I could use a haircut" depending on data captured in the soil. Apart from the pleasant chat with plants, the garden will provide visitors with a physical representation of the many ways AI could be used to improve sustainability (可持续性) and conservation efforts moving forward.

When the garden is completed, it will rely on a network of sensors throughout the garden measuring environmental factors like soil moisture and nutrient levels as well as wind and projected rainfall. All of that data is then sent to a specially designed AI model housed in a room at the back of the garden. The model, powered by Microsoft's Azure OpenAI Service, can then analyse those factors and inform gardeners of feeding, watering and trimming (修剪) plants.

Tom Massey, one of the garden's two designers, described the project as a "unique

opportunity". "I am excited to see how AI can assist gardeners to help make a meaningful impact that will help us all garden and grow more sustainably," Massey said in a recent interview.

How to add green tech to your home

Green tech involves combining technology and science to create environmentally-friendly products. The idea is that by using products and services in the home to reduce energy consumption, waste, or harmful effects on the environment, we can all help the planet. 1.

Install smart light bulbs.

One quick way to reduce energy use is to switch all your light bulbs to energy-efficient versions called smart bulbs and use a virtual assistant to control them. A

AI generators (生成器) and the avatars they create are developing rapidly. UK-based company Synthesia aims to move this technology further. Recently, it announced Expressive Avatars, which can show a lot of lifelike human feelings. These avatars are part of what Synthesia calls its "digital actors". They have improved facial expressions and human-like voices—an upgrade from other AI systems' robotic sounds.

Synthesia offers more than 160 AI avatars, under the agreement of real human actors. Users can produce videos in more than 130 languages. CEO Victor Riparbelli said that they are not coming for Hollywood; instead, they focus on companies and B2B content, which need communication videos that are easy-to-create and human-like, such as in areas like health care.

Synthesia's Expressive Avatars are powered by its Express-1 AI model. It was trained only on content produced in-house, avoiding false data (数据). Riparbelli explained that the company hired thousands of actors to record videos for the model to ensure exactness.

The show presented an avatar reacting to words like "I am happy". The avatars' speech style is more natural than previous models. Riparbelli said, "Whether the conversation is cheerful or serious, our avatars change their performance accordingly, showing a level of care and understanding that was once the special area of human actors."

The possible misuse of this technology is a concern, especially considering the risks of deepfake (深度伪造) technology. "We've taken additional steps to prevent the misuse of our technology, including updating our policies to limit the type of content people can make, working on the early finding of dishonest actors, and

increasing the teams that work on AI safety," the company said in an announcement.

Synthesia believes that Expressive Avatars will help businesses produce videos that are not only informative but also caring. Riparbelli said, "I think we're looking at an important shift in capabilities within the next six to nine months."

Do you ever look at your dog, or cat, or a bird flying by the window and wonder, "What on earth are you thinking?"

So many of us regard the animals around us as extensions (延伸) of ourselves, having long and deep conversations with our animal friends and supposing they can completely understand everything we are saying to them.

The gap between human and non-human communication is still huge. But will there ever

be a time when we'll be able to talk to animals and they can reply in the same way? While it seems to be fantastic, could AI and new technologies further the development of animal translation?

Animals communicate by a wide variety of different means. Most of this communication is message passing between the same species, but between-species communication is also rich. Think of an insect or fish changing colour to warn off attackers or remind them of their toxicity (毒性). But can these happen between humans and other animals?

Any dog owner knows that if you shout at a dog for some wrongdoing, the dog knows it is being told off and answers accordingly. But there is a danger in thinking that animals can fully understand human communication. We human beings have our own awareness and specific human experience. The rest of the animal kingdom experiences the world in a way quite different from ours. So, even if we could understand what their calls mean, would we be able to catch what they are trying to say?

So how can developing technologies help in our understanding of animals? For many years, companies have been saying they've created apps that can "translate animals", but many of these have been unbelievable or can only offer a very basic level of communication. The development of AI systems and deep learning algorithms (算法) has advanced the idea of using big data to make some kind of dictionary of animals' vocabulary.

Until now the usual way we identify dogs is with microchipping. In some countries it's even the law. But a company from South Korea has developed an app that can identify dogs a little less invasively. On this phone, I've got the new app, PetNow, which is now using the dog's nose print to identify a dog, just like you can use a fingerprint of a human to make identification. A dog's nose print is very similar as well.

"Now show me your nose, buddy." It takes me a few seconds to take pictures of the dog's nose. "Oh yes, I made it, okay! Then who is the dog? Is it Emma, Lenard, Karl, or Ethan?"

The app analyses the data in the cloud and tells me that this is Emma, and not only that, it's showing me that Emma's been reported as missing. And it's telling me where she was reported missing, and I can share my location with the owner, so they can be reunited.

Unlike a microchip, which could be cut out of a stolen dog, you can't really remove a dog's nose, not without spoiling the dog. And by using the phone's camera to scan, anyone in theory can check a stray dog without any specialist equipment.

Recently, I've spoken to PetNow to find out why they'd settled on nose prints for dog recognition. There may be paws or ears, but some dogs really hate showing up, sharing their paws or their ears. Their nose is actually exposed all the time. And after a dog becomes six months old, the nose print stays there for its entire life, so they believe that it is the best part for identification.

PetNow hopes its app will become <u>mandatory</u> in South Korea to help reduce the number of dogs that are abandoned by pet owners. To do that they will need the backing of the government and a huge marketing push, so that everybody

including people who don't own a dog must install the app and know how to use it.

There is a new kind of robot called Rubion which can smartly tell ripe (成熟的) strawberries, picking them without <u>bruising</u> them and putting them into its basket. It sounds impossible but it is true. Its appearance is not only an answer to the labour shortage in the agricultural industry, but it also allows growers to increase the quality of produce, which in the end benefits the consumers.

It has been a fact that there is a labour shortage in the agricultural industry. But for Octinion Technology Group, the focus is clearly on adding quality. "Thanks to robotics, we have so many possibilities, much more than a human could ever do. Harvest prediction, picking according to market needs, simply picking when the berries are ripe instead of when workers are available—these are just a few examples of what is possible now for a grower," says Tom Coen, CEO of the Octinion Technology Group. "The consumer will also notice the difference, as strawberries will be fresher and show less bruising."

Introducing robots into an industry where almost everything gets done by hand is more of a revolution (变革) than evolution. It needs close group action with all partners. Tom Coen says, "Not only have we been working together with growers and test centres across the world for the past few years, but breeders (培育者) have been active in being part of the technological development."

In 2022, a team of Belgian engineers started the development of the robot. In the meanwhile Octinion wasn't the only company presenting an idea. Product Manager Laura Guillaume says it's not a surprise that the company from Leuven is the first to actually present a commercial product. "By developing the robot from the beginning, we are able to make it practical in greenhouses or tunnels." Octinion plans to develop harvesting robots for other crops in the future.
