Adaptation and innovation (创新) of traditional opera is an important trend in the Chinese opera circle in recent years. In order to attract young audience of the new generation and catch up with the time, the traditional opera circle makes efforts to create new works. In recent years, traditional opera has come across the change of time and society. It gradually lost the main elderly audience and was not attractive to the young.

In order to find new opportunities, using modern sound, light and digital stage effects, China's traditional Peking Opera, also known as *jingju*, is appealing to young people in a fashionable and innovative way, as the classic art faces an aging audience.

The centuries-old Tianleyuan Theatre in Beijing has taken the lead in introducing fashionable performances of Peking Opera. The opera combines instrumental music, vocal performances, mime (哑剧表演), dance and acrobatics (杂技).

Tianleyuan has a *jingju* art experience section and fashionable performances. It has attracted more than 2,000 audience members, mostly young people, according to theatre staff.

“Good art should keep pace with the times, so does *jingju*,” said Zhang Zishang, a 22-

year-old performer of *The Drunken Beauty*, one of the classic *jingju* plays performed in the theatre. “I feel today's performance is very special,” Zhang added. She was born into a family of *jingju* performers and has had 10 years of stage experience. “Innovation is good, but we must also carry on the basic elements of *jingju*,” another young performer Deng said.

According to Deng, innovation is perhaps the best way for *jingju* to deal with the problem of an aging audience. Tianleyuan Theatre has made successful attempts to combine *jingju* with local opera forms such as ballet when organizing performances abroad. “Innovation can help traditional arts go further. We are happy to see many young faces, and some of them even come twice to experience the ‘new’ art,” she added.

Nowadays, using entertainment to feel better, relax, and escape from stress is common, and holiday movies are a popular choice for this purpose. Many media companies have noticed this trend and are creating more holiday “feel-good” movies. Why? Holiday movies make us happy.

Psychologists explain happiness in two ways: Hedonic happiness is what we get from feelings of pleasure and enjoyment. It tends to be more transitory, like eating chocolate. Eudaimonic happiness, however, comes from experiences that create a sense of meaning and purpose and tends to be with us longer.

Holiday movies can give us both kinds of happiness. They make us feel good with humour, love stories, beautiful settings, likable actors, and happy endings. And they also remind us of important things like hope, love, and being connected to others, which adds deeper sense of meaning.

Although holiday movies are well-known

for being predictable or simple, that’s part of what makes them comforting. They are guilty pleasures that make us feel good—we don’t expect critical praise. We just want to make sure that the world will be put right. The characters face challenges. A disappointed hero struggles, makes great efforts, and finally achieves not just happiness but the true meaning of the holiday spirit through love or family support.

The predictability also provides comfort. No matter how unbelievable or simple it is, the plot touches real emotions. The predictability means we also enjoy re-watching favourite holiday movies, because the familiarity feels good and safe, knowing everything will end well and feeling connected to “home” on holidays. These movies can refresh memories and shared experiences that make the holidays more meaningful.

So, if you feel guilty about liking holiday movies next time, don’t be! They combine happy and emotional moments, which are good for both your mind and body. They help us laugh, feel empathy, and enjoy the holiday spirit.

Lin-Manuel Miranda began writing what would become *In the Heights* as a university student. The musical play would make him a playwright and performer. Now, 20 years later, it has been made into a movie, which is in theatres for its first weekend.

Miranda said like other artists, he was not only driven by his dream but also by something else. “It was a lot of fear, honestly,” Miranda said in a recent interview. “I was 18 and started to study theatre. The fear was that I was going into a domain that had no space for me and that had no roles for me. It was sort of that thing: no one was going to write your dream show.”

In the Heights opened on June 10. It celebrates many things: the Latino immigrant experience, neighbourhood communities in New York City and life itself.

The movie was supposed to be shown in June, 2020, but was stopped by COVID-19. The film’s director, however, thinks the delay (推迟) was not necessarily a bad thing. Moviegoers

might be ready for some energetic music, singing and dancing after a year of limited life.

Many performers acting in the first *In the Heights* Broadway show appear in the movie’s final song and dance. Students from a nearby high school also can be seen in the film. The students had produced their own *In the Heights* show which the film-makers watched and found moving.

Others starring in the movie include Leslie Grace as Nina Rosario, a college student at home for the summer; Corey Hawkins as Benny, a taxi driver; and Melissa Barrera as Vanessa, a beauty salon worker trying to get her own home. Thirty-year-old Barrera said the part she plays as a young woman searching for a better future away from home is basically herself.

Dolphins love to play around, doing things like surfing, playing with stuff, and running after each other. However, have you ever been to a wildlife park and seen dolphins opening their mouths wide? Researchers uncovered that dolphins use the “open mouth” facial expression to show their cheerfulness, instead of attack.

Other animals use their faces to show they want to play, but it wasn't known if sea creatures do the same thing. This led the team to carry out this study. They recorded videos of 22 dolphins that lived at two wildlife parks. The dolphins were recorded when they were playing in pairs, playing with their human trainers and playing on their own.

During the 80 hours of video footage, the scientists counted 1,288 times when the dolphins used the “smile” expression. The team said 92% of those happened when dolphins were playing with each other. They seldom used the expression when they were playing on their own or with humans. Nearly 90% of the expressions happened when a dolphin could see their playmate's face. If other dolphins spotted their “smile”,

they returned the expression around a third of the time. Elisabetta Palagi, a biologist, said that the relaxed open mouth “is a universal sign of playfulness, helping animals and us signal fun and avoid misunderstanding”.

The research focused on dolphins in parks. Those living in the wild could behave differently when playing. It's possible that while playing in more open spaces, dolphins might prefer to communicate using sounds instead of facial expressions. “Future research should study eye-tracking to explore how dolphins see their world and take advantage of acoustic signals (声学信号) in their communication during play,” added Livio Favaro, a co-author and zoologist, in the press.

This research throws light on the unique communication skills used by these intelligent sea creatures as well as the importance of facial expressions to set the right intentions (意图).

The Academy Awards, which are more widely known as the Oscars, consist of a collection of awards aimed at honouring outstanding artistic and technical achievements within the film industry. These awards are presented annually by the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences, an institution located in Beverly Hills, California, the US. Winners of the Academy Awards are chosen from 24 categories including best picture, acting awards, directing, screenplays, technical aspects, and various film types. And they will receive a gold-plated statue commonly called Oscar.

To be eligible for an Oscar award in a given year, a film generally must be publicly exhibited for paid admission for at least one week at a commercial theatre in Los Angeles between January 1 and December 31 midnight of that year. Exceptions to this rule include foreign-language films, which are submitted by their country of origin and need not have been shown in the United States. Documentaries and short films have different eligibility requirements and are officially submitted by their producers, whereas music awards require the musical artist to file a submission form.

Only members of the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences can recommend and vote for Oscar candidates. The academy is divided into various branches of film production. For each award category, the candidates are selected by the members of the corresponding branch. That is to say, writers recommend writers, directors recommend directors, and so on. The

entire academy membership recommends the candidates for best picture and votes to determine the winners in most of the categories.
