A desire for offline connection is driving a UK book club revival, offering a way to escape screens and loneliness. From celebrity-backed groups like Dua Lipa's to "silent" clubs, these gatherings prioritize community as much as literature. "The rise reflects a hunger for deeper bonds," says Holly Cooke, founder of The Lonely Girls Club, which expanded into book clubs amid growing demand.

Statistics prove the trend: book club lists on Eventbrite jumped 350% post-2020, while "book club" reentered Meetup's top 10 search terms. Clubs like Glasgow's Feminist Book Club, founded by Stefanie McCartney, now attract up to 40 attendees monthly.

Today's clubs combine literature with themed experiences—like detective night dinners or knitting (针织) circles—to serve specific audiences. Identity-focused groups, such as Literally Black Book Club, create safe spaces for minority group communities. Silent book clubs, meanwhile, offer connection through shared quiet reading.

As technology advances, people are facing heightened social isolation (孤单). Loneliness and digital overload are key drivers. "The isolation emphasized our need for meaningful interaction," Cooke explains. Book clubs provide structure, McCartney adds, allowing people to engage however they choose.

As screen fatigue (疲惫) grows, many seek <u>refuge</u> in physical books and in-person discussion. Cooke says: "People want a break from screens, like how music fans enjoy old-style records or people write diaries." Clubs without alcohol are also popular. More clubs

now don't focus on drinking. McCartney states: "We need choices besides drinking." Member Laura Menendez likes that and thinks it's not about buying things; it's about being together, not spending money. Celebrities like Dua Lipa and Kaia Gerber have intensified the trend, drawing younger audiences.

In an age of disconnection, book clubs combine tradition with modern needs, proving shared reading is anything but outdated. As Cooke notes, "It's never been more relevant. They provide a space where ideas are challenged, broadened, and enriched through collective discussion, offering connections and the insights after the pages are turned, leaving a remarkable mark on the community."

How people communicate with one another varies wildly from culture to culture. In our fully globalized times, it is more important than ever to understand these differences and where they come from. One way to obtain such an understanding is through the concept of high-context and low-context cultures, developed by Edward T. Hall.

High-context cultures use communication that focuses on underlying context, meaning, and tones in the message, and not just the words themselves. On the contrary, low-context cultures expect the content of communication to be evidently stated so that there's no risk of confusion, and if a message isn't clear enough, it will slow down the process of communication. In the most extreme cases, leaving any sort of wiggle room for interpretation can be catastrophic (灾难性的).

Although it can be a complex characteristic whether a culture is high-context or lowcontext, it can determine many other aspects of a particular culture. For example, in a highcontext culture, similarity is an important characteristic. This is because the majority of the population in high-context cultures typically have the same level of education, as well as a shared ethnicity, religion, and history. Through these shared experiences, messages can be contextualized by assuming an audience will think in the same way and follow the implicit message in someone's speech or writing. In low-context cultures, the opposite is true. Lowcontext cultures are usually diverse, and focus on the individual, instead of the group. Communication must be basic enough to allow for as many people to understand it as possible.

Just as communication in general is different for high-context and low-context cultures, the forms of communication also vary. Generally, high-context cultures prefer oral communication, while low-context cultures favour written communication. When it comes to e-mails, texts, and online messaging, it is more common to send brief and frequent messages in low-context cultures. Low-context cultures also want the communication to focus on basic questions, like: What's happening? Where's it happening? When's it going to happen? High-context cultures will tend to move in the other direction, with a focus on longer forms of communication that don't always focus on basic questions.

In Burnham-on-Sea, a bright yellow sign marks "The 'Happy to Chat' bench: sit here if you don't mind someone stopping to say hello." This bench was designed to deal with loneliness among the elderly in the seaside town. The bench has become a place where people like Ann, who has lived alone since her divorce 13 years ago, can strike up conversations with strangers. Ann explains that even just seeing the bench can spark a conversation, leading to natural interactions about holidays, local life, and personal stories.

Another example of engineering opportunities for real human interaction is the "Chatty Café Plan". Started in 2017 by Alexandra Hoskyn in the UK, the initiative encourages cafés to designate a "Chatter & Natter" table where customers can sit if they are open to chatting with others. The plan has expanded to other countries, including Australia, Canada, and the United States, aiming to reduce loneliness by creating a welcoming space for conversation.

Real human connection is significant for our physical and mental well-being. Social interactions can reduce stress, lower the risk of depression, and improve the overall mental health. Physically, engaging with other people is capable of boosting our immune system, and even increasing longevity (寿命).

In a world that seems so connected through the Internet, phones, and social media, why are we having to engineer human interaction? Despite the rise in social media, many people still feel disconnected. Social platforms often provide superficial (肤浅的) connections rather than meaningful interactions, leading to a dilemma where we are more connected digitally but feel lonelier in real life.

Perhaps it is time to get off the Internet, put down our phones, and remember that we are social beings. Start by talking to your neighbours, chatting with the person in the queue, and engaging with your colleagues. Attend local community events, join clubs or groups that interest you, and try to reconnect with friends and family.
