When I took my children outside, I saw them change. At first they looked at me as if to say: "What are we doing? The cartoons are on!" Thirty seconds later, their eyes moved away from the 30cm zone that screens occupy.

This supports my decision to make a documentary, *Project Wild Thing*, to find answers. But what are the questions? I've settled on these: Is nature good for children? Why don't children love nature as much as TV? Yet when they get close to it, why are they so happy?

When I started to find what would happen if my kids went outside more, I realized that the things children love are constantly marketed. Marketing seems like the best way to get kids to love nature. I've discovered a surprising truth and called myself marketing director for nature.

I have made an app that reconnects people to nature. I have been sneaking around London replacing signs with advertisements for the great outdoors. But I've come to wonder then whether I should be selling nature. Maybe it's the one thing we shouldn't. I think I've found another way. Rather than adding nature's voice to the noise of marketing, I started to work with ex-marketers from different fields, using an e-platform to develop a way to connect the

thousands of groups who all want children to connect with nature.

Nowadays, using entertainment to feel better, relax, and escape from stress is common, and holiday movies are a popular choice for this purpose. Many media companies have noticed this trend and are creating more holiday “feel-good” movies. Why? Holiday movies make us happy.

Psychologists explain happiness in two ways: hedonic happiness is what we get from feelings of pleasure and enjoyment. It tends to be more transitory, like eating chocolate. Eudaimonic happiness, however, comes from experiences that create a sense of meaning and purpose and tends to be with us longer.

Holiday movies can give us both kinds of happiness. They make us feel good with humour, love stories, beautiful settings, likable actors, and happy endings. And they also remind us of important things like hope, love, and being connected to others, which adds a deeper sense of meaning.

Although holiday movies are well-known for being predictable or simple, that’s part of what makes them comforting. They are guilty pleasures that make us feel good—we don’t expect critical praise. We just want to make sure that the world will be put right. The characters face challenges. A disappointed hero struggles, makes great efforts, and finally achieves not just happiness but the true meaning of the holiday spirit through love or family support.

The predictability also provides comfort. No matter how unbelievable or simple it is, the plot touches real emotions. The predictability means we also enjoy re-watching favourite holiday movies, because the familiarity feels good and safe, knowing everything will end well and

feeling connected to “home” on holidays. These movies can refresh memories and shared experiences that make the holidays more meaningful.

So, if you feel guilty about liking holiday movies next time, don’t be! They combine happy and emotional moments, which are good for both your mind and body. They help us laugh, feel empathy, and enjoy the holiday spirit.

American actor Marc Herrmann says he’s finally able to call himself a full-time working

actor—thanks to Chinese micro dramas. He's one of many Hollywood professionals finding opportunity as China's short drama platforms gain in popularity in the US and reshape the global streaming (流媒体) market.

Behind the boom is the fact that China's mini-drama industry has developed a complete ecosystem, reshaping the viewer market in film and TV with its "short, fast, and catchy" features. According to the 2024 White Paper on the Development of China's Micro Drama Industry, the American micro-short drama market reached 50.4 billion *yuan* (about \$7.03 billion) last year, beating box office income for the first time. The success of Chinese short dramas overseas is not about spreading domestic (国内的) content, but about localized reinvention in themes and visual language for the overseas market.

Xu Wensong, an associate professor at the School of Cultural Industry Management at the Communication University of China, told us that Chinese short dramas are characterized by appealing storylines, an ability to deliver high emotional value and instant entertainment. With improving production quality, these short dramas hold a certain competitive edge in international markets. "Chinese platforms are good at adjusting content to local tastes," Xu said.

Micro drama production has restructured the traditional logic of the film and television industry. A Hollywood film editor said that an increasing number of micro dramas funded by Chinese companies, developed by Chinese creative teams, and starring Hollywood actors are being produced in Los Angeles. This, he said, has "rescued" many Hollywood professionals who were on the brink of unemployment.

Sun Jiashan, an associate researcher at the Central Academy of Culture and Tourism Administration, noted that the overseas development of Chinese micro dramas symbolizes a significant practice of "cultural output in the digital age". Sun believes that micro dramas may become an important tool for China's cultural soft power, carving out a different path in the global streaming competition.

Hollywood writers scored a major victory last month in their battle over how artificial intelligence can be used in future film and television projects.

Experts say the contract guidelines between the Writers Guild of America (WGA) and the Alliance of Motion Picture and Television Producers (AMPTP) could offer a model to workers in Hollywood and other industries. The writers' contract does not outlaw the use of AI tools in the writing process, but it sets up protections to make sure the technology stays in the control of workers, rather than being used by their bosses to replace them.

The new rules guard against several occasions that writers had feared, comedian Adam Conover, a member of the WGA negotiating committee, said. One such situation was studios being allowed to generate a full script using AI and then demanding that a human writer complete the writing process.

"Under the new terms, studios cannot use AI to write scripts or to edit scripts that have already been written by a writer," Conover said. The contract also prevents studios from treating AI-generated content as "source material", like a novel or a play that screenwriters could be assigned to adapt for a lower fee and less credit than an original script.

"For instance, if the studios were allowed to use ChatGPT to generate a 100,000-word novel and then ask writers to adapt it, that

would be a loophole (漏洞) for them to reduce the wages of screenwriters," he said. "We're not allowing that." If writers adapt output from large language models, it will still be considered an original screenplay, he added.

Simon Johnson, an economist at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology who studies technological transformation, called the new terms a "fantastic win for writers" and said it would likely result in better quality work and a stronger industry for longer. The union win on AI is also not a loss for the studios, he noted, since they will get a better product from this arrangement than they might have otherwise.

A TV series in Wales has become a heated issue by becoming the number one choice for teenagers to watch.

This educational means works because it creates a psychological distance. When teenagers discuss the problems of an ancient king or hero, they can more easily explore similar feelings in their own life—like pressure, anger or confusion—without feeling directly judged. As one educator explained, it allows students to look at life through art, making personal issues feel more manageable.

The project has shown amazing results. It helps students build empathy (同情) by connecting with characters from another time. More importantly, it develops their critical (批

判性的) thinking skills when they discuss the characters' difficult choices. Finally, by connecting with these ancient characters, students get a new understanding of their own challenges, discovering that their feelings and questions are part of a shared human experience that dates back thousands of years. Therefore, they may learn from similar situations and make necessary changes if possible.
